








## Springer Nature platforms saw almost 250 million visitors in 2016; both are among the 1,000 most popular global websites


## Kazakhstan: Visitors to SpringerLink and their behavior on the website Jan-May 2017





### Kazakhstan SpringerLink Usage 2016 (Full Year)-2017 (May)




## Kazakhstan in comparison: number of articles in 2015 (SCImago journal and country ranking)




### **Total Journal Articles Published with Springer 2006 to 2017**

- Considering multiple authorships, we see altogether 6,334 contributions from researchers from Kazakhstan Academic Customers during that time period.











### **Top 20 Institutions by Articles Published with Springer 2006 to 2017**



### Journal Articles Published with Springer by Subject Area




### **Book Chapters Published with Springer 2006 to 2016**


#### Book Chapters Published

- Taking into consideration multiple authorships, we see altogether 954 contributions from researchers from Kazakhstan Academic Customers during that time period.


#### **Book Chapters by Years of Publication**




#### **Book Chapter Authorships by Years of Publication**
